Course abstract

This course provides an overview of the main policy players and the major common policies of the European Union. The emphasis will be on understanding the reasons for particular choices of policy actions, taking into account the preferences of individual member states and of the various EU institutions, as well as the changing international context.

Teaching methods: The form of studies: lectures, seminars, case studies. Study types: research, literature studies, literature overview, essays

Learning outcomes

On completion of this course, students will be able to:

- demonstrate an overall understanding of an appropriate scholarly discourse;
- analyze and evaluate topics and concepts related to the course contents;
- demonstrate their knowledge related to the course topics and show systematic and critical understanding of theories and their practical applications;
- analyze cases and key problems related to the main themes of the course; •use strong arguments for their opinions in time of discussions

Requirements for awarding credit points

- 1.Attendance of lectures is free option.
- 2.Attendance of seminars is compulsory. You are expected to attend each seminar.
- 3.Active participation in seminars by taking part in:
 - presentations of the seminar topics on the basis of required readings and ability to answer additional questions,
 - discussion and debate about the issues raised in the seminar, which will be judged in terms of the quality and thus will give a possibility to receive additional points.
- 4.Seminar presentations should be submitted electronically until 6.00 p.m. in the day of seminar.
- 5.Essays should be submitted as hard copies and electronically in a timely fashion. Failure to submit an electronic version along with the hard copy of your individual coursework (essay) will be treated as failure to submit. Penalties for late submission: one degree less per each day.
- 6.Essays should be fulfilled corresponding to the methodological instructions. Papers must be typed, in length between 13-15 pages, one and half-spaced, and in 12 point type.
