"Re-adapt the Ruin" is a programme dedicated to revitalizing abandoned urban spaces through innovative engineering, architecture, and urban planning. Participants will collaboratively create solutions to transform these areas into socially and economically valuable community assets, supporting Europe's vision of a sustainable, inclusive social economy.



On site

The programme begins with an introductory online session, followed by a transformative week-long on-site experience in Limbaži, within a vacant building complex repurchased by the municipality. Immersed in a creative and collaborative environment, participants will explore adaptive reuse through hands-on research and challenge-solving. Guided by mentors and industry leaders, they will dive deeper into sustainable materials, innovative technologies, inclusive urban regeneration, and community-driven design solutions. The experience aims to blend visionary thinking with practical skills, reimagining urban spaces aligned with contemporary Bauhaus principles of functionality, inclusivity, and resilience.
